\$70,000 per year for up to 3 years.

August

- A vision which will be of benefit to Australia

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be an Australian citizen
- Have completed, or be about to complete, a degree from an Australian university with outstanding results
- Plan to start a post-graduate degree at an overseas institution in 2019
